James Arthur "Jim" Strosnider, Jr., age 89, of Woodstock, passed away Friday evening, January 11, 2013, at Greenfield Senior Living of Woodstock.

Mr. Strosnider was born May 31, 1923 in Strasburg, a son of the late James Arthur and Virgie Alice Shillingburg Strosnider, Sr.

He was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Woodstock, American Legion Post 199, Woodstock, VFW Post 2447, Edinburg and was a veteran of the [United States Navy](#) having served during [World War II](#). He served in the Air Force Reserves after his discharge from the Navy. Jim was a certified Master Plumber, Certified Master Electrician and a Certified Steam Fitter.

He was a graduate of Strasburg High School, Coyne Electrical School in Chicago, Illinois, Johnson Pneumatic Heating and Air Conditioning Control School, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, General Electric Heating and Oil Burner School, Bloomfield, New Jersey and studied heating and air conditioning at Virginia Polytechnic Institute (Virginia Tech), Blacksburg, Virginia.

He was the weightlifting champion of the United States Navy 1944-45 and weightlifting champion of Virginia 1946, 47 and 48. He was Maintenance Supervisor and Administrative Aid to the superintendent of Shenandoah County Public Schools for 28 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife and mother of his children, Marcelene Hope Craun Strosnider; two sisters, Virginia Scott and Elsie Scott; and his step-daughter, Vonda Kaye Wright.
